

Kansas Criminal Justice Information System Management Control Agreement For Consolidated Dispatch Centers

Whereas: Only criminal justice agencies or non-criminal justice agencies under the management control of either a criminal justice agency or a governing board as defined below are authorized to participate on the KCJIS, FBI CJIS, NCIC, and NLETS criminal justice telecommunications networks.

And

Whereas: Management control includes, but is not limited to, the supervision of equipment, system design, programming, and operating procedures necessary for the development and implementation of the network connections.

_____, a Consolidated Dispatch Center, agrees to:

- 1) Comply with all policies as set forth in the following documents: (1) the NCIC 2000 Operating Manual and related TOUs; (2) Title 28, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 20 (3) FBI CJIS Security Policies and (4) KCJIS Administrative Policies and Procedures. The Center is also subject to applicable federal and state laws and regulations.
- 2) Execute a Criminal Justice ORI User Authorization Agreement with each criminal justice agency it serves, and provide copies of each to the Kansas Highway Patrol CJIS Unit.
- 3) Apply for and operate under a separate Originating Agency Identifier (ORI) assigned by the FBI. Application is made by contacting the Kansas Highway Patrol CJIS Unit.
- 4) Operate under the management control of either:
 - a) A criminal justice agency or;
 - b) A governing board of which a majority of members represent criminal justice agencies or;
 - c) A governing board (without a majority representing criminal justice agencies) with a sub-committee entirely of criminal justice representatives with oversight concerning the following issues:
 - i) **Priorities** – any measures necessary to provide the criminal justice community with priority service.
 - ii) **Standards** – necessary to ensure that whoever selects, supervises and terminates personnel adheres to safeguards required to maintain the integrity of criminal justice systems and networks.
 - iii) **Policies** - governing the operation of computers, circuits and telecommunications terminals used to access criminal justice systems and networks.

In lieu of individual criminal justice agency or governing board member signatures, a document, such as a local resolution or ordinance, that sets forth the establishment of a criminal justice governing board and lists the title and agency name of each representative of the governing board, may be appended to serve as individual members' representative signatory.
